## **EVA & ADELE: ADSILA**



After the great success of the solo exhibition OBSIDIAN in 2013, Nicole Gnesa presents new works by EVA & ADELE for Munich's 2014 Open Art.

The basis for the **ADSILA** series are works begun before EVA & ADELE met. As with earlier similar series such as TRANSFORMER-PERFORMER, the ADSILA collaborations are like palimpsests – layered, perforated and interwoven, i.e. the heart throb logo ("Herzkopflogo") –

alluding to their ongoing performance - and as the uppermost layer the large abstract drawing of a flower in white. These motifs are taken from the 64 drawings in the ADSILA sketchbook that were based on photographs of the flowers in EVA and ADELE's studio, influenced by the Mediterranean landscape. The strokes using graphite are few but precisely executed in their surprising abstraction and the resulting poetic substance.

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Coinciding with the exhi-bition is the art book ADSILA, their 15<sup>th</sup> monograph, edited by Nicole Gnesa and pub-lished by Hirmer Verlag. The lifelong, permanent and worldwide performance of internationally renowned artists EVA & ADELE is one of the most radical in contemporary art.

EVA & ADELE's work has been exhibited in over 30 solo exhibitions from New York to Helsinki. Their paintings, drawings, sculptures, photographs and videos are to be found in the world's most important collections such as the Tate Gallery in London or the Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris.
